CITY OF ROME GREEN WASTE AND BRUSH PICKUP

The Department of Public Works will begin the collection of green waste and brush pickup for the inside corporation district starting April 17th, 2017. The City of Rome Department of Public Works will pick up your green waste the day before your regular rubbish pickup day. For example if your rubbish day is Tuesday, your green waste will be picked up on Monday. This schedule will continue until our leaf schedule begins in October 2017. Contractors are prohibited from placing green waste and brush at the curb; they are responsible for their own disposal.

All green waste must be containerized; no loose piles of green waste will be picked up. Please use either (5)-five 30 gallon containers or (5)-five 30 gallon 100% biodegradable lawn + leaf paper bags, plastic bags will be left at the curb. Each container or bag shall weigh **no more than 50 pounds**. These bags are sold at Ace, Tops, Price Chopper, Wal-Mart, and Lowe's. Please remember that no foreign matter should be co-mingled with green waste, such as: paper, household garbage, stones, concrete, or animal feces.

Please remember, brush and limbs should be cut up NO more than 5 feet in length with butt ends towards the road, limbs should be **no larger than 6" in diameter** and manageable by hand. There will be NO shrub/root ball pickup at the curb. All Rome residents can bring their green waste, brush, limbs larger than 6" in diameter and shrubs/root balls to the Rome City Yard located at 132 Race Street Monday through Friday during the hours of 8:00AM to 2:00PM beginning April 17, 2017 and Saturday's from 8:00AM to 12:00PM beginning April 22, 2017.
