BETWEEN W. DOMINICK STREET AND GIGLIOTTI AVENUE FOR FOOD TRUCK VENDORS  
IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SPRING FLING EVENT ON THE GRIFFO GREEN.**

WHEREAS, Kimberly Rogers, Third Ward Councilor for the City of Rome, New York, has requested the closing of a portion of N. Washington Street, between W. Dominick Street and Gigliotti Avenue, for food truck vendors in conjunction with the Spring Fling Event, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on April 28, 2018; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, that the Common Council of the City of Rome, New York, does hereby authorize the closing of a portion of N. Washington Street, between W. Dominick Street and Gigliotti Avenue, for food truck vendors in conjunction with the Spring Fling Event, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on April 28, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this authorization is contingent upon the above organization providing the City of Rome with a certificate of insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and death/property damage and a minimum general aggregate coverage of \$2,000,000, naming the City of Rome as an additional insured, and indemnifying and holding the City of Rome harmless from any and all liability arising out of the closing of a portion of N. Washington Street, between W. Dominick Street and Gigliotti Avenue, for food truck vendors in conjunction with the Spring Fling Event, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on April 28, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the above authorization shall take effect upon placement of the appropriate barriers at each end of the affected area.

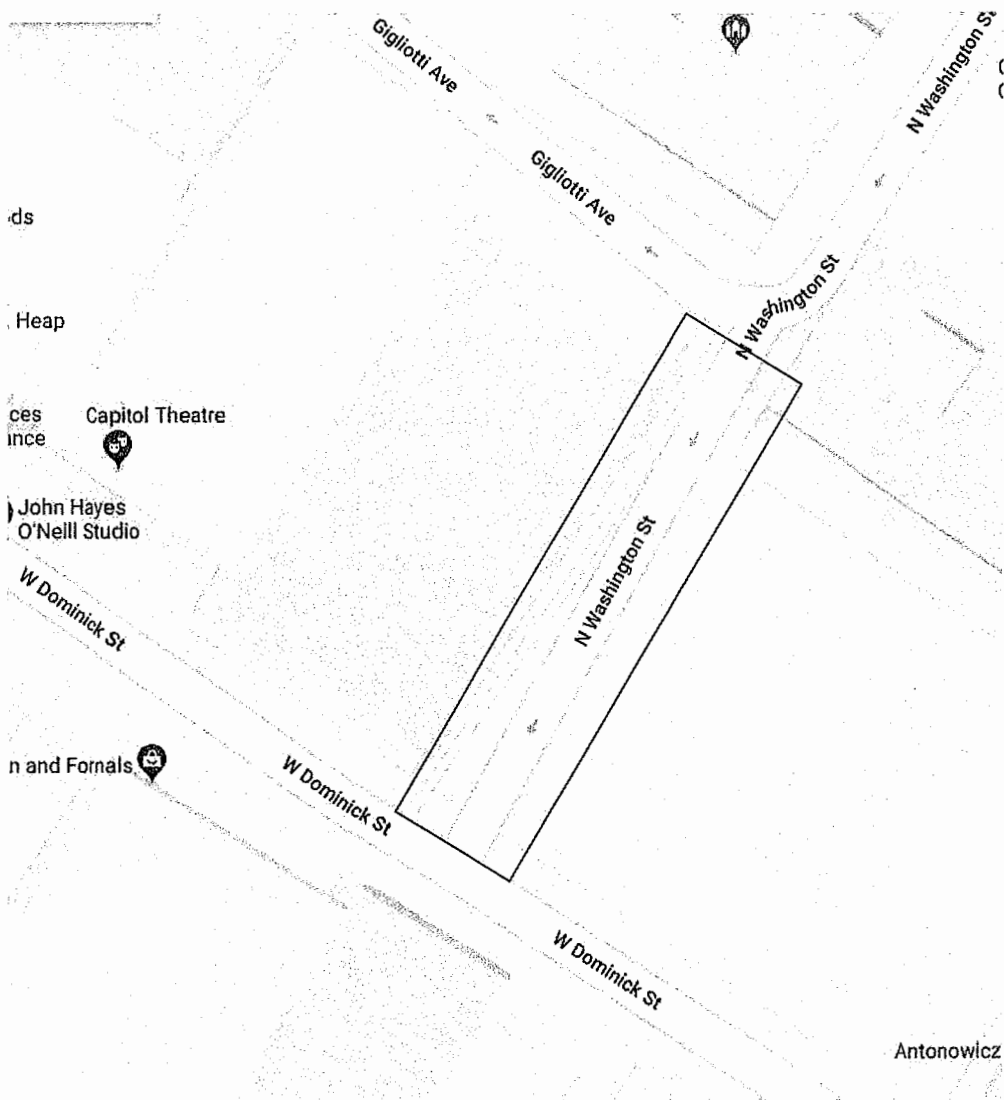
