Re: Levitt Rome #8 115kV Asset Refurbishment Project

Village of Camden, Town of Williamstown, and City of Rome, New York

Dear Neighbor:

National Grid's commitment to our customers and communities begins by providing safe, reliable service, and meeting the increasing demand for energy. To that end, National Grid will be making improvements to our infrastructure to meet customer needs. We are writing you to introduce the project and provide you with information about upcoming activities in the project area.

National Grid is planning to replace structures and associated electrical equipment at select locations along transmission lines nearby. While some of these operations can be completed without an outage along the line, a select portion of structures needing upgrades will require an outage for safe installation. Select locations along the route will need to use mobile generators onsite to allow for continued flow of electricity to our customers.

Generators will be located at four locations:

- In the Town of Williamstown near NYS Route 13 at the Omega Wire complex
- In the Village of Camden near Railroad St. and Mexico St. by International Wire Group
- In the City of Rome near N. Levitt St. and W. Embargo St. at the National Grid Substation
- In the City of Rome, north of S. Jay St. at the National Grid Substation by Worthington Industries

These generators will need to run for 24 hours for approximately 7-10 days around April 13th – 20th 2021. The generators look like typical rectangular shipping containers.
