**MAINTENANCE WORKER AT WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

**GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:** Helps to repair and maintain machinery and equipment at a municipal Water Pollution Control Plant. Does related work as required.

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** The work involves the efficient and worker-like performance of a variety of repair and maintenance tasks involving sewage treatment plant equipment. General instructions are received regarding work of ordinary difficulty, permitting leeway for planning technical work details. Detailed instructions are usually received for new or difficult assignments. The work is performed under general supervision of the Chief of maintenance with leeway allowed for the exercise of independent judgment. Supervision may be exercised over the work of helpers and laborers.

**TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:** (Illustrative only)

- Performs a wide variety of repairs to pumps, mechanical screens, gritting equipment, chlorine machines, sludge and grit conveyors, filters and piping, and other pneumatic and hydraulic equipment;
- Inspects and performs preventative maintenance on pumping machinery, conveyors, filters, grit chambers and other plant equipment;
- Performs a wide variety of electrical, mechanical and plumbing work;
- Lubricates and cleans pumps and other machinery;
- Assists in the installation of new equipment;
- May operate automotive equipment occasionally;
- Reports to the Chief of Maintenance regarding assignments;
- Periodically perform work in a hazardous atmosphere and confined space;
- Cleans and Maintains work area;
- Does routine cleaning as required.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:**

- Good knowledge of the operation, maintenance and repair of pumps and auxiliary equipment;
- Good knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and accident precautions of one or more of the mechanical trades;
- Ability to work from plans, specifications and rough sketches;
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions;
- Initiative and resourcefulness in solving mechanical problems;
- Ability to get along well with others;
- Dependability;
- Mechanical aptitude;
- Manual dexterity;
- Reliability;
- Good judgment;
- Good physical condition.
